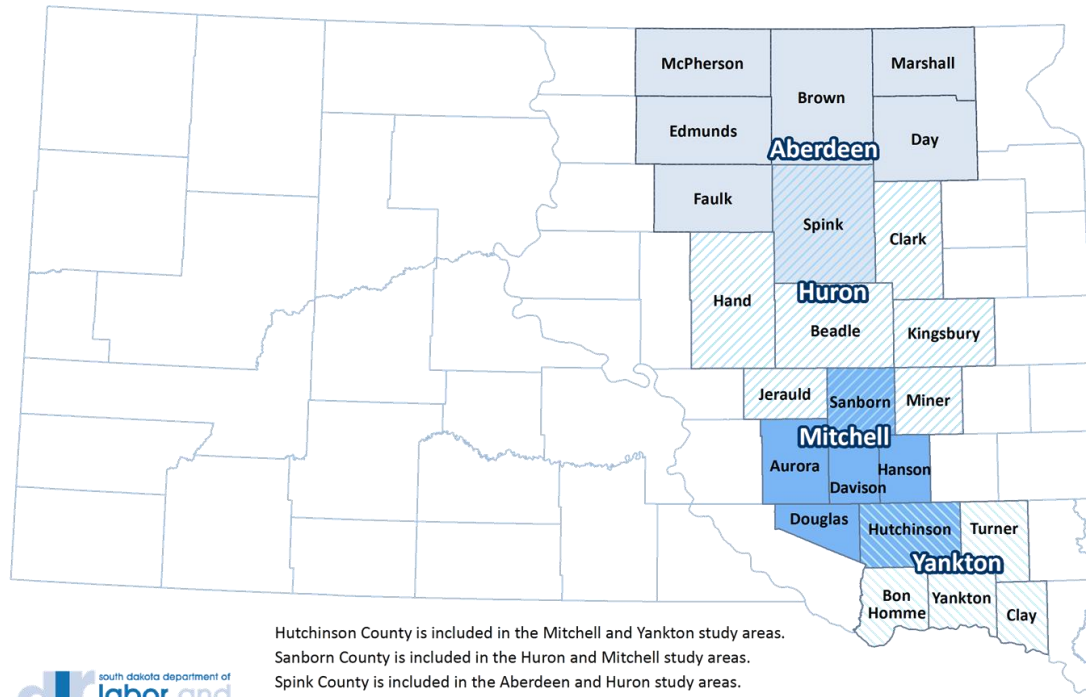

Select Regional Economies in South Dakota



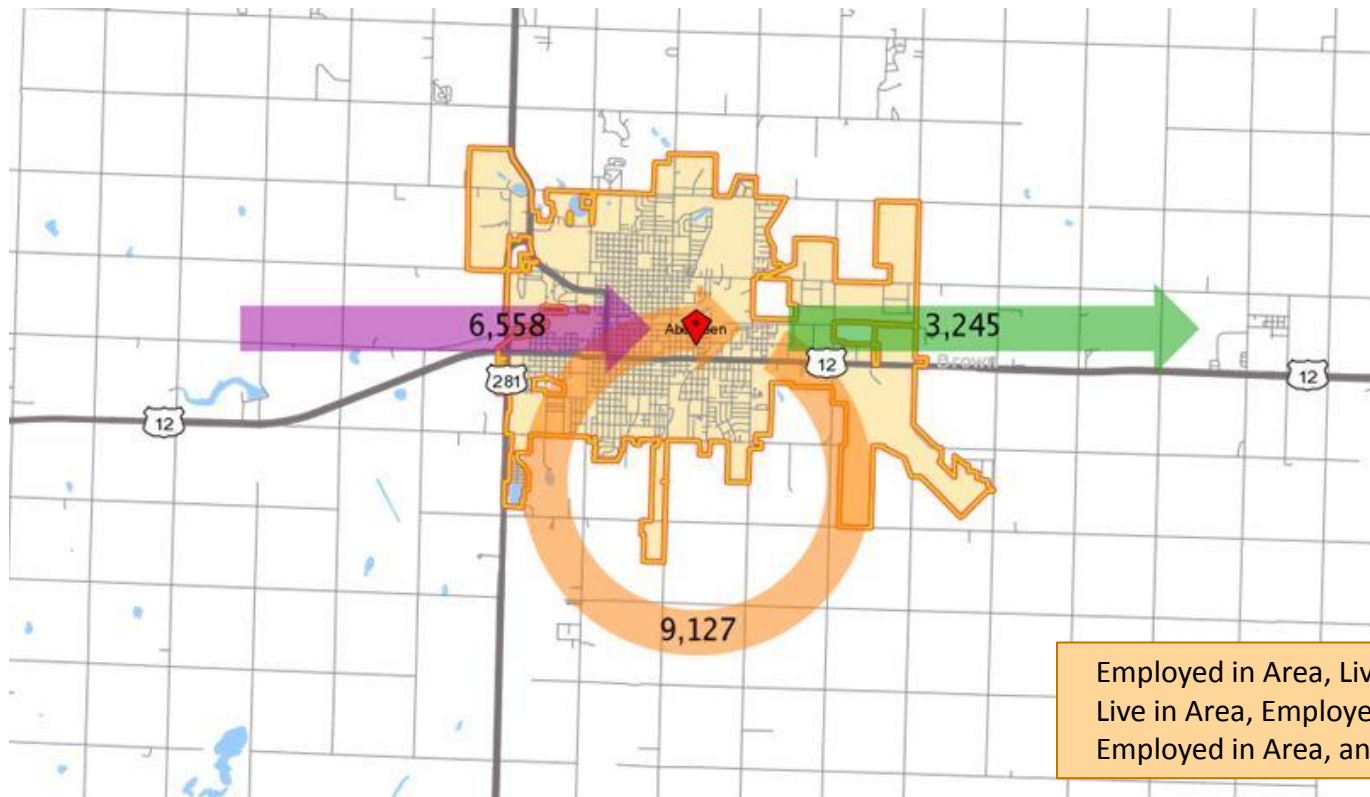
Hutchinson County is included in the Mitchell and Yankton study areas.

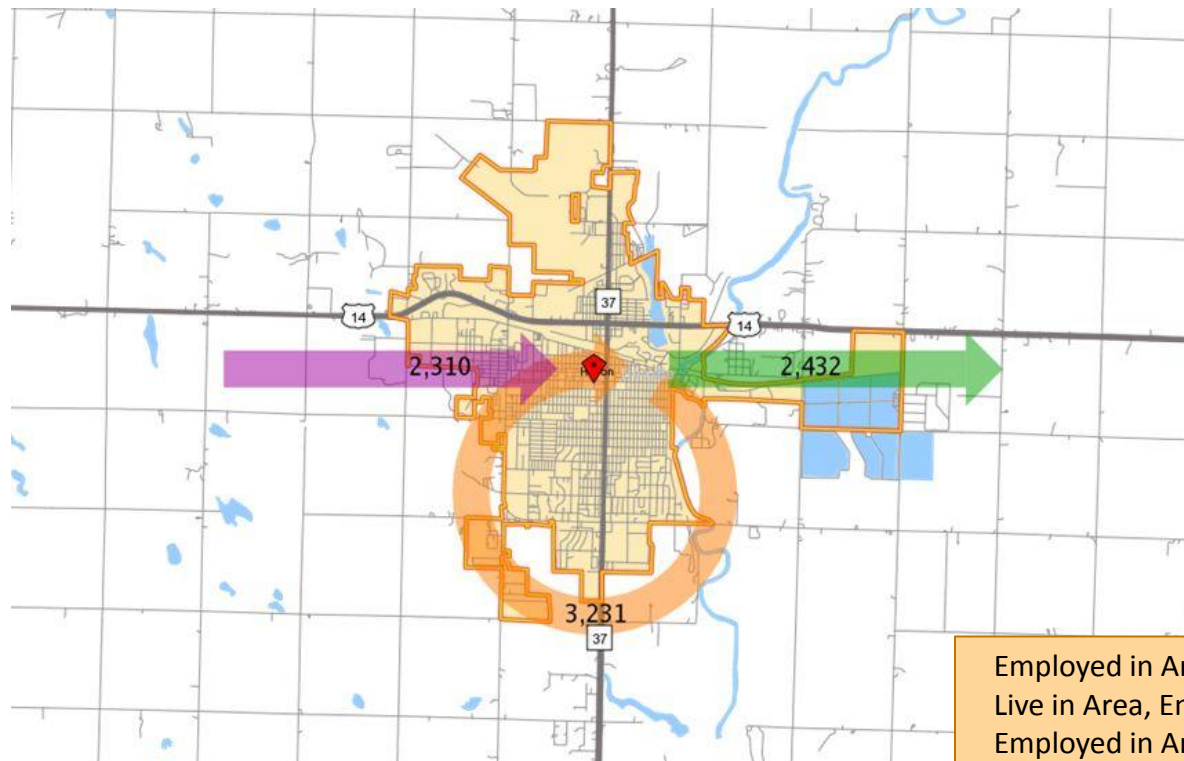

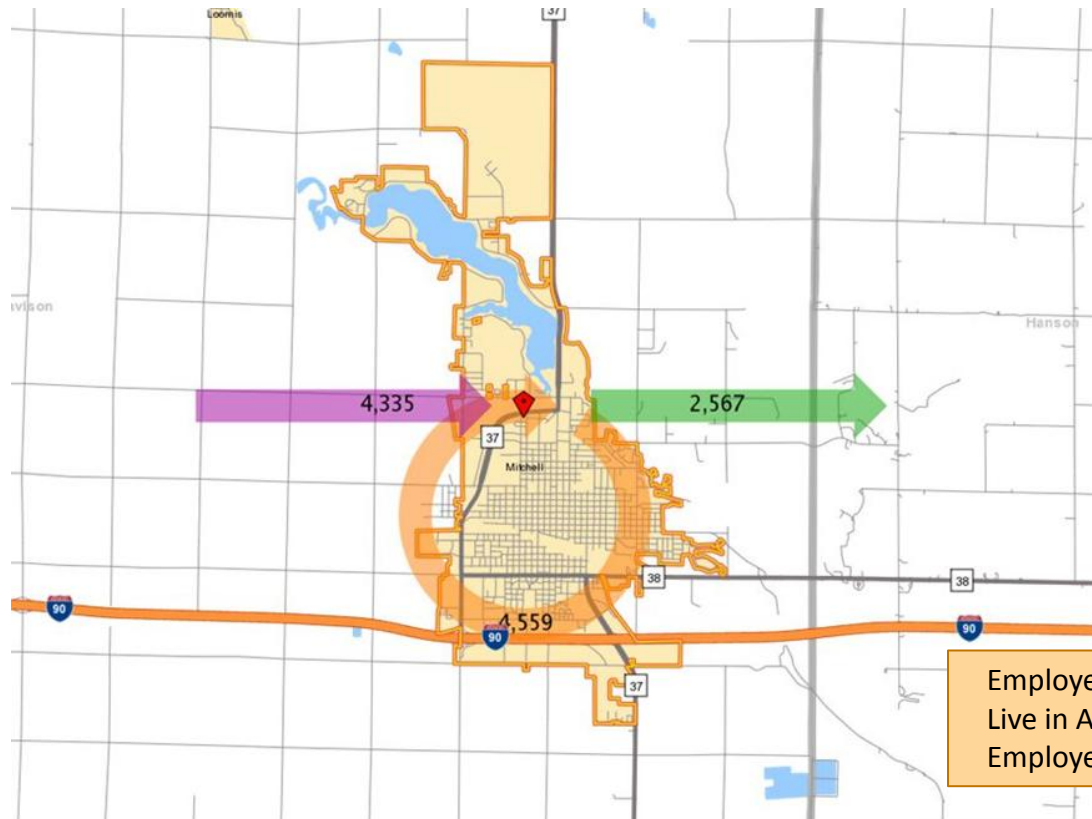

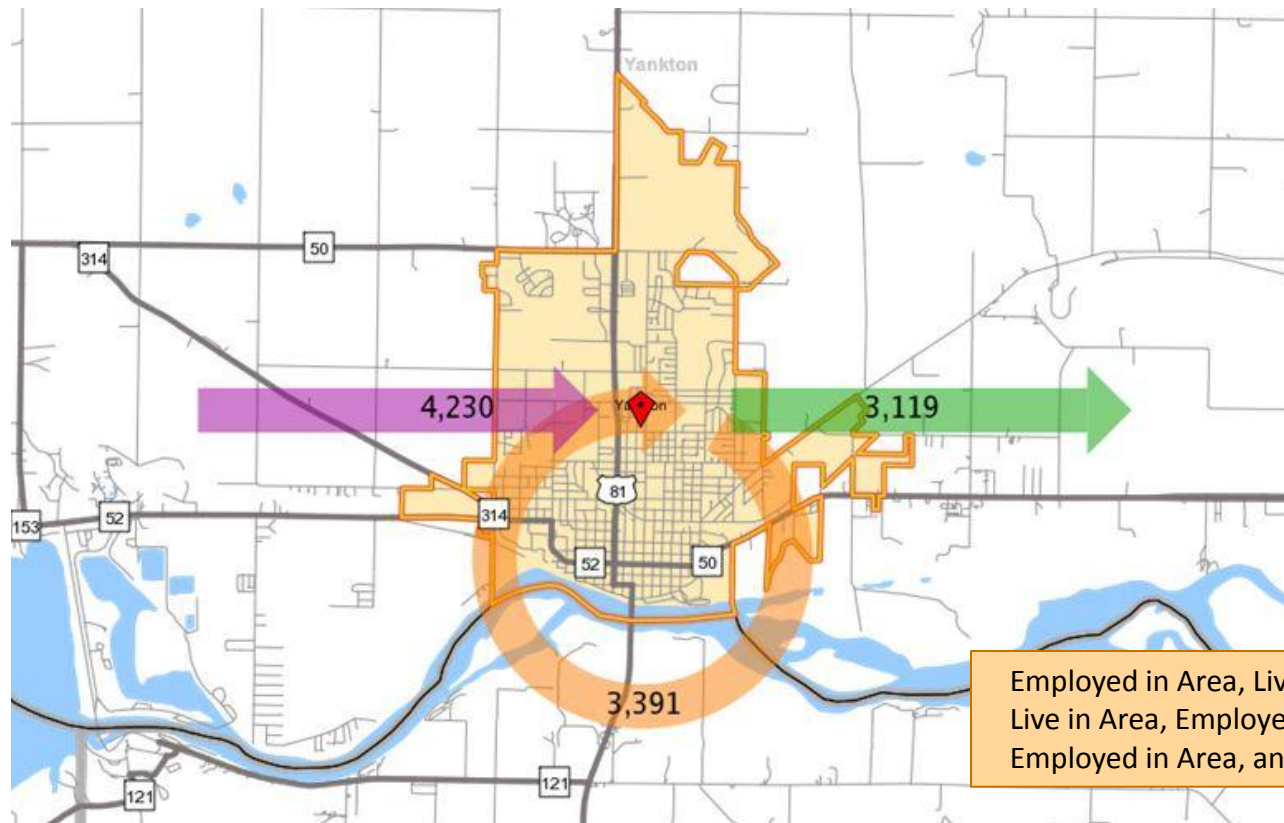
## OnTheMap data for Mitchell City (Primary Jobs)
